- Procurements/expenditures not listed on the previous slide:
  - **Verizon** funds support the use of surveillance cameras for use in narcotics investigations (NOTE: While not all drug company settlements authorize restricted use funds for narcotics enforcement activities, some do and funds are tracked to ensure authorized amounts are not exceeded.
  - Axon Enterprises Tasers to support Sullivan County Sheriff's Office operations (unrestricted funds)
  - **Stipend** provided to two employees (Senior Budget Analyst, Confidential Secretary to the DA) to perform work in support of the Drug Task Force that is outside of the employees' title/job description
