

14. Cultural, Historical and Recreational Resources

The natural beauty of Sullivan County has always dazzled. In the 19th century, city travelers discovered the pleasant haunts where they could fish, stroll and dream. Centuries later, the natural attractions still inspire; only a 90 minute drive away from New York City, but a world away.



Ideally situated in the foothills of the scenic Catskills, Sullivan County offers the best of both worlds – convenient access to major metropolitan areas and a relaxed, rural lifestyle. We are home to covered bridges, dairy farms, church steeples, a bustling arts community and the hallowed grounds of the original 1969 Woodstock Festival.

Sullivan County offers 1,800 bodies of water and 1,000 miles of streams, including the world famous Willowemoc and Beaverkill. It stands to reason why fly-fishing was invented here. Plus, the county has the largest population of bald eagles in the east. For a little more action, there are 18 championship golf courses and plenty of opportunities for mountain biking, hiking, canoeing, winter skiing, snowmobiling, ice fishing and more.

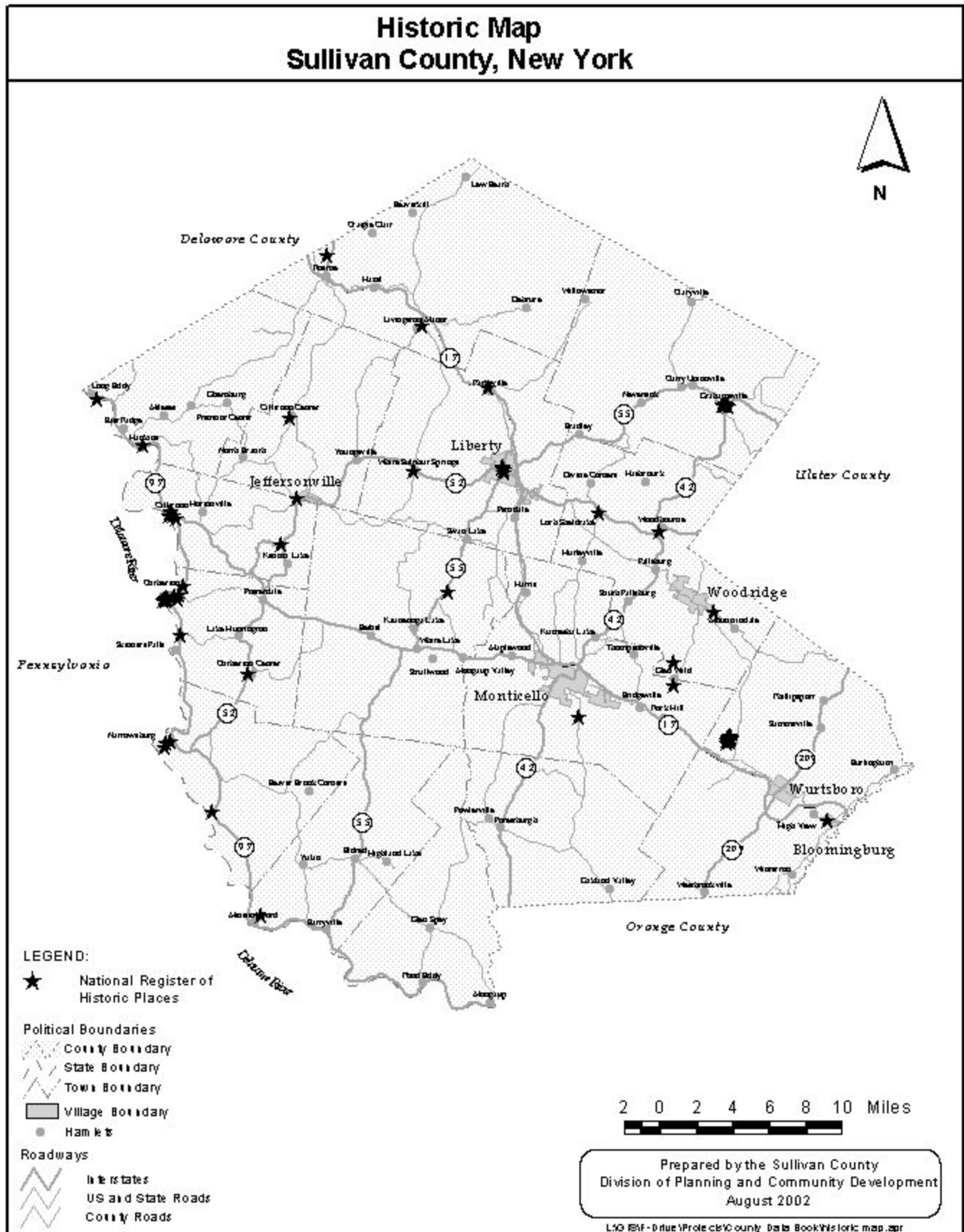

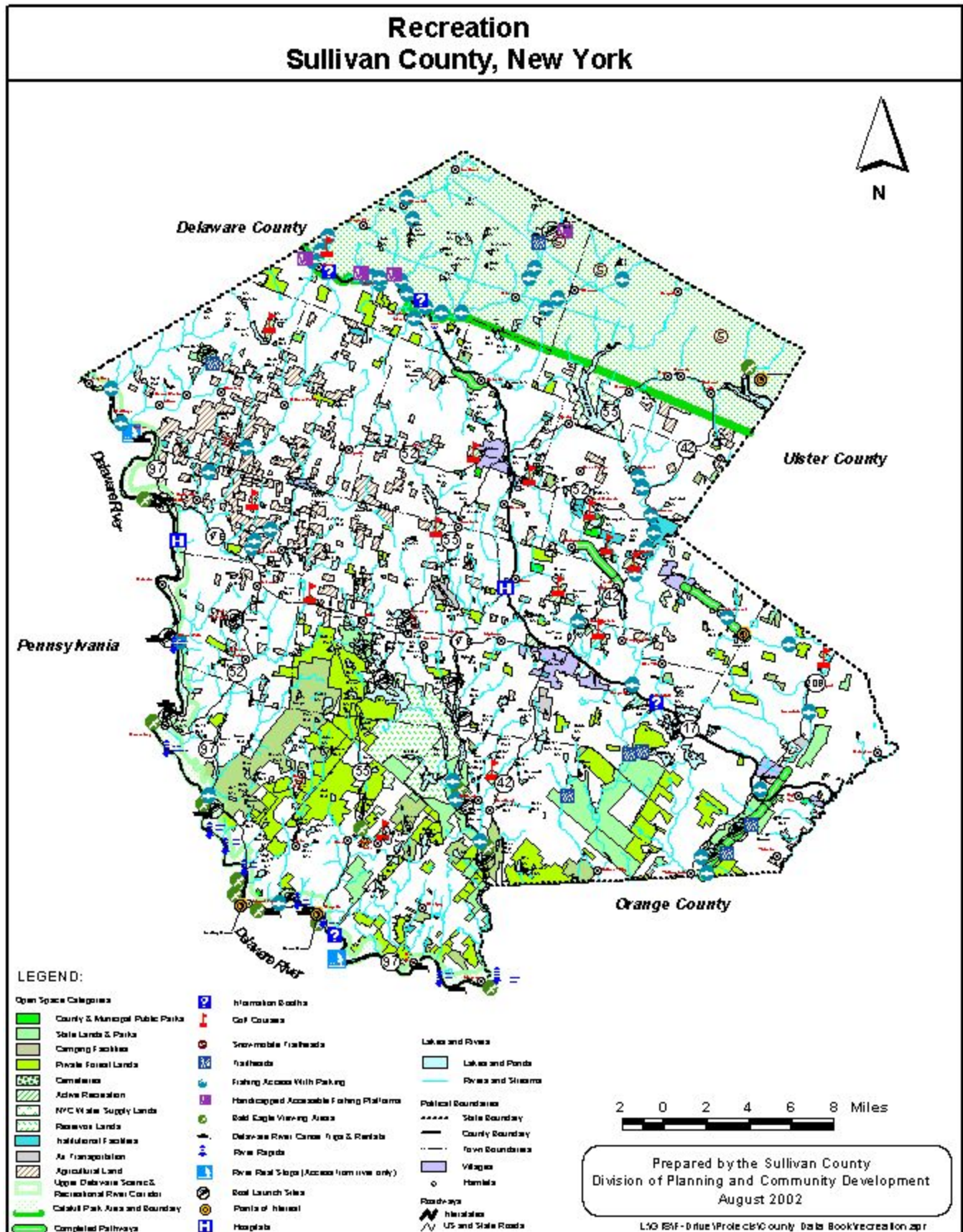

Shad Fishing

Every Spring there is a contingent of Delaware River anglers who eagerly await the arrival of the annual spawning of American Shad. The Shad spends most of its life in the Atlantic Ocean until an age of three to five years and weight over five pounds. Then they return to the Delaware River System in which they were born to spawn themselves. The peak of the Shad run is generally in May, with adult Shad present in the river through June and even into late July in some years.

Fishing

Fly fishing, fresh water fishing! Famous streams like the Willowemoc and the Beaverkill! Be here for the traditional opening of the trout season on April 1st at Junction Pool. Or fish the Delaware River and our beautiful lakes. We're famous for "Trout Town, USA" – that's Roscoe... And ice-fishing every Winter!

Hunting

Enjoy hunting in-season for deer, bear, turkey, and small game on public and private lands. The Catskills offer many areas, contests, co-op lands, and the services of licensed guides. You will need a permit in all cases. In 2001 the "Big Day" is Monday, November 19th, the opening of deer season. Call or write for your free copy of the Sullivan Co. "Hunting Bulletin."
