

2. Government

In 1995, Sullivan County moved from a Board of Supervisors form of government to a County Legislature. The new County Charter established nine legislative districts in the County with each legislator serving four-year concurrent terms. In January following each election year, the nine elected legislators hold an organizational meeting to elect a Chairperson and Vice Chairperson of the Legislature. The Chairperson then appoints a Chair, Vice Chair and three members to each of the Legislative Committees. These persons hold their positions for a two-year term and a mid-term organizational meeting is then held to again select the leadership of the Legislature. Presently, the Chairlady of the Sullivan County Legislature is the Honorable Leni Binder and the Vice Chair is the Honorable Robert Kunis.



The Legislature is responsible for appointing the County Manager, policy making, County laws and adopting the County budget. The County Manager is the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the County and responsible for the day-to-day administration of the County government and preparation of the County budget. Total appropriations in the Sullivan County FY 2002 budget were \$161,900,952.

Over the years, the County of Sullivan has passed through a process of legislative change common to many American communities. While only a few simple laws were necessary when the County was established, subsequent growth of the community, together with the complexity of modern life, has created the need for new and more detailed legislation. The orderly collection of these records is an important step in this process. Legislation must be more than mere chronological enactments reposing in the pages of old records. It must be available, logically arranged for convenient use, and kept up-to-date. It was with thoughts such as these in mind that the County Legislature ordered the *Codification of the County's Legislation*, which was completed in 1999.

The various chapters of the Code contain all current effective local laws of a general and permanent nature enacted by the County Legislature of the County of Sullivan, including revisions and/or amendments to existing legislation deemed necessary by the County Legislature in the course of the codification.

The Code is divided into three major divisions. The first division includes the Charter of the County, the second division includes the Administrative Code and the third division includes all legislation of a general and permanent nature as Parts I and II. Part I, Administrative Legislation, contains all County legislation of an administrative nature, such as that dealing with the administration of government, that establishing or regulating municipal departments and that affecting officers and employees of the municipal government and its departments. Part II, General Legislation, contains all other county legislation of a regulatory nature. Items of legislation in this part generally impose penalties for violation of their provisions, whereas those in Part I do not.
