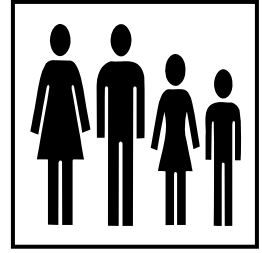


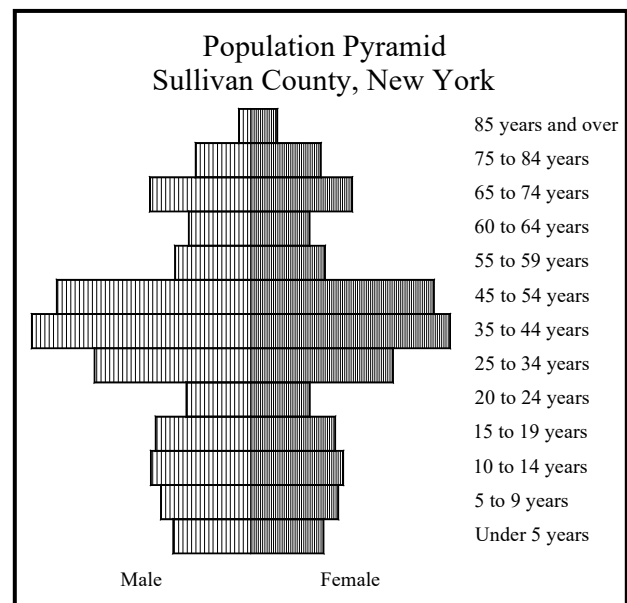
3. Population

According to U.S. Bureau of the Census, Sullivan County had a year 2000 population of 73,966 persons, a 6.77% increase from the 69,277 persons recorded during the 1990 Census. This makes Sullivan County one of the fastest growing counties in New York State and our growth rate is anticipated to accelerate during the next decade. Factors influencing growth in Sullivan County include the County's desirability as a place to live, its affordability when compared to Orange County and the rest of the New York metropolitan region, and recent community and economic revitalization efforts.



Although the County's population increased overall, there are variations in the growth rate by Town and Village that are worth noting. For example, the towns that have experienced the most increase in population since 1990 are Lumberland (36.07%), Forestburgh (35.67%), Neversink (20.40%), Bethel (18.12%) and Mamakating (12.36%). Mamakating gained the most people out of this group (1,210) since 1990, however the percent change is lower since Mamakating's base population was large. Mamakating has the third largest population of any town in the County. It also has a large bedroom community that works in either Orange County or the New York metropolitan area. With the cost of housing in the Mid-Hudson region pricing homeowners out of the Orange County market, more people will continue to be attracted to Sullivan County. These factors will only accelerate population growth in the years ahead.

The age structure of the County's population is rather interesting. As illustrated by the "*population pyramid*" graph to the right, the 35 to 44 age group displays the largest percentage of the population as it did in 1990, and an increase from 10,639 to 12,121 persons representing that group. The 45 to 54 age group (14.8%), and the 35 to 44 age group (11.7%) then follow this group, which contains 16.4% of the population. The trends are similar to the 1990 data. The population pyramid also clearly shows the longer life expectancy of women vs. men which is a national phenomenon.



According to the 2000 Census data, Sullivan County had an overall population density of 73.1 persons per square mile in 2000. This is an increase compared to the 68.5 in 1990. Densities in the towns for the year 2000 ranged from 14.7 in Forestburgh to 156.8 persons per square mile in Thompson.

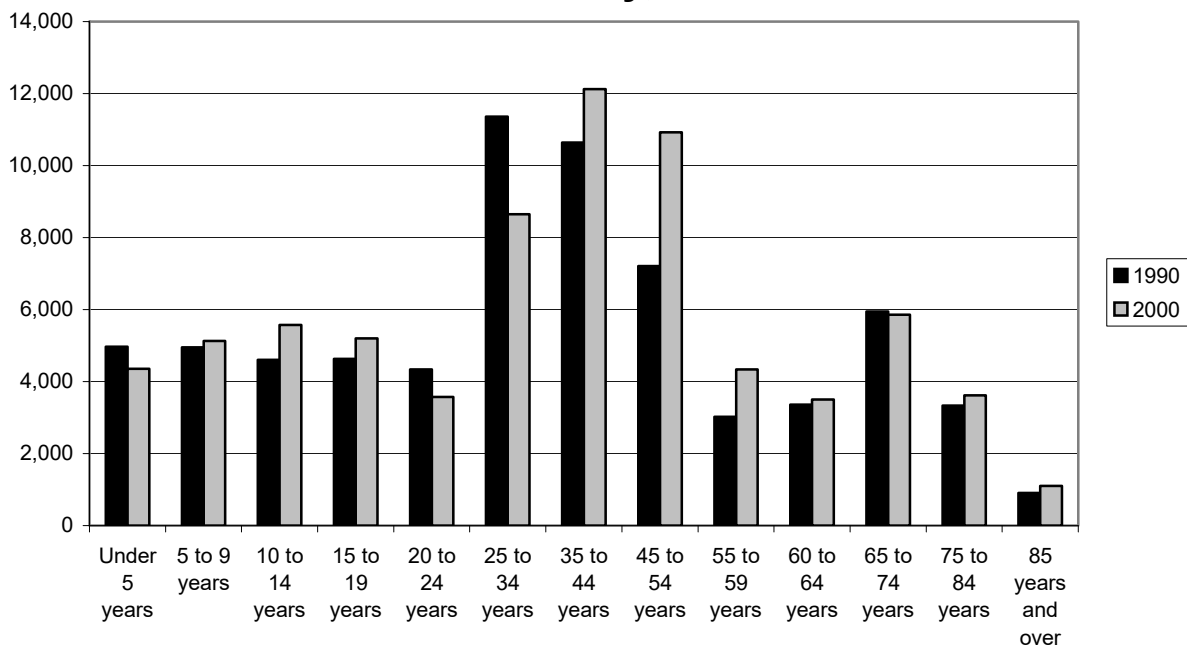
In terms of the race and Hispanic origin, the composition of the County population has been relatively unchanged since 1990. In 2000, the percentage of persons describing themselves as being of a particular race was as follows: 85% White, 8.5% Black, 1.1% Asian and 5.4% Other. Approximately 9.5% of the County's population indicated that they were of Hispanic or Latino origin.

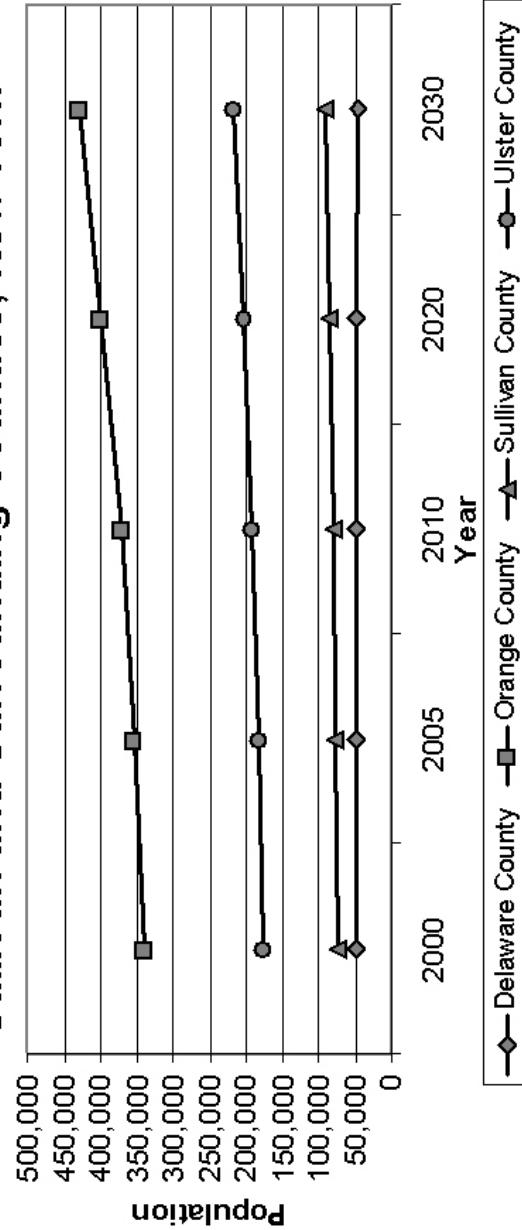

Population Projections, 2000 - 2030 Sullivan and Surrounding Counties, New York



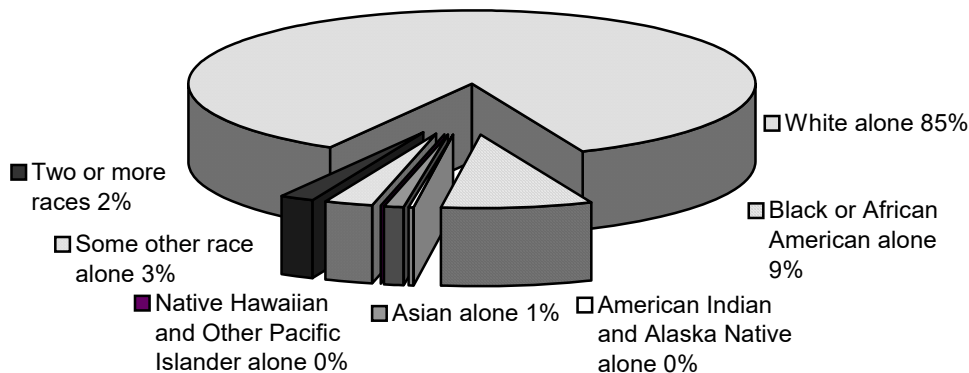

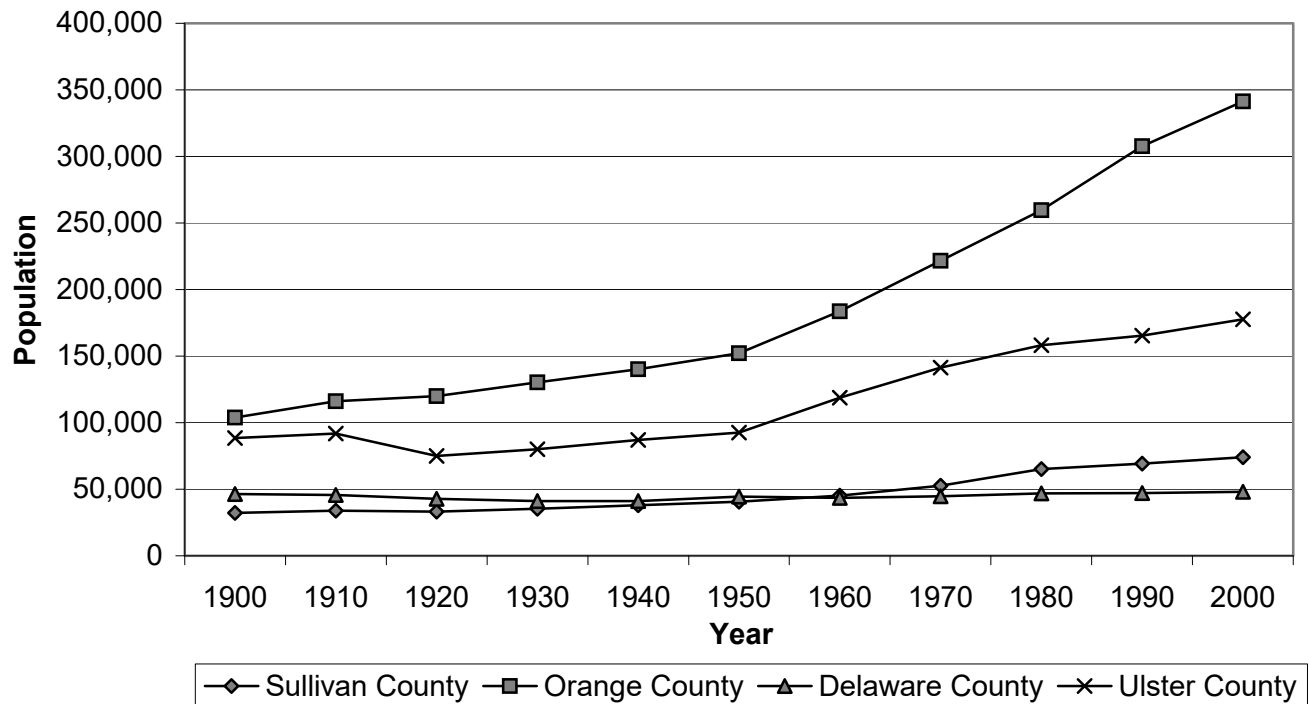

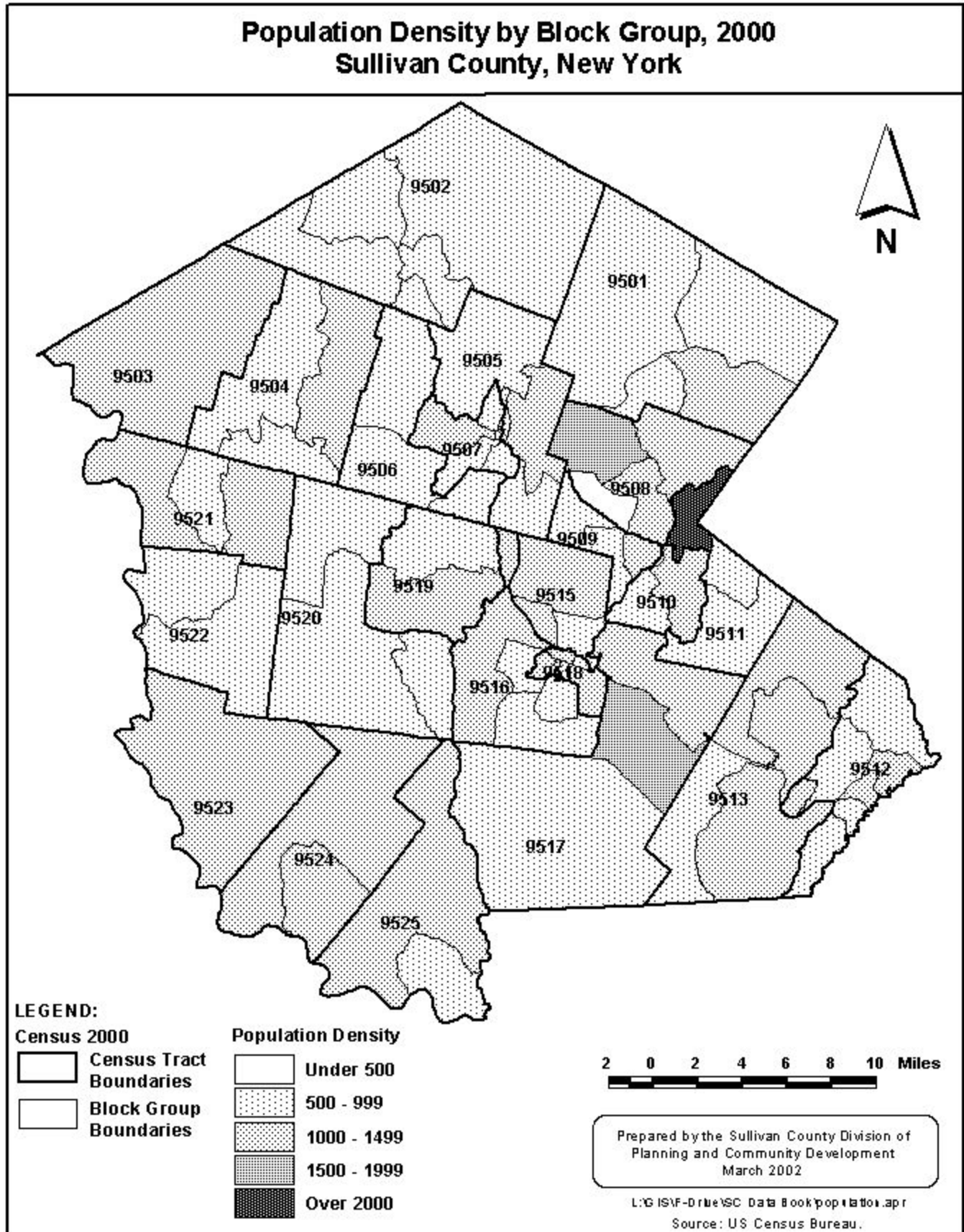

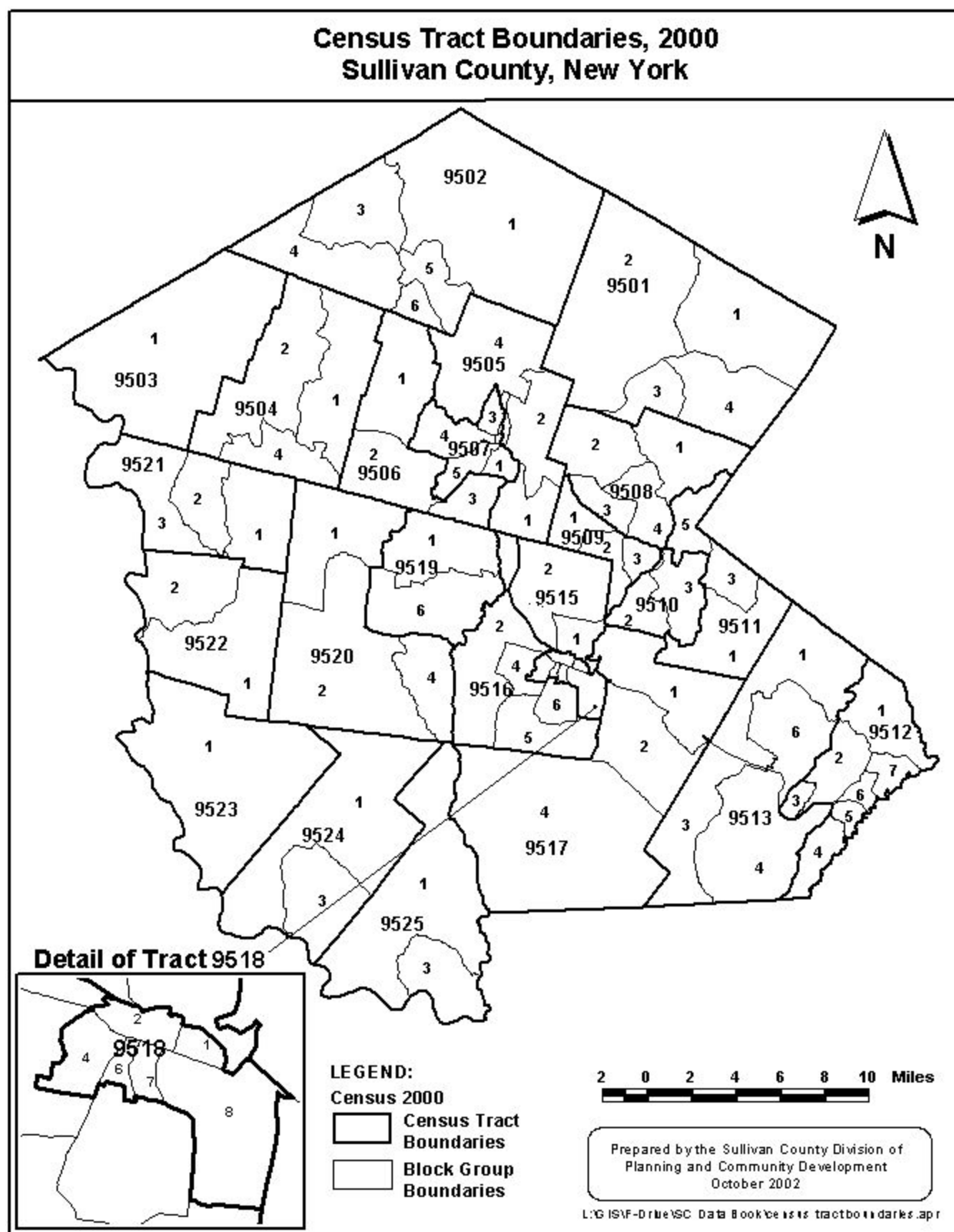
