

Education

In 2020, Sullivan County had 8 public education school districts as follows: Eldred Central School District, Fallsburg Central School District, Liberty Central School District, Livingston Manor Central School District, Monticello Central School District, Roscoe Central School District, Sullivan West Central School District, and Tri Valley Central School District. As of December 2024, Livingston Manor Central School District and Roscoe Central School District approved to merge to become Rockland Central School District. As a result of this change, Sullivan County now has 7 public education school districts.

In addition, there are 4 school districts that extend into and serve parts of Sullivan County, with the main locations of these districts located within either Orange or Ulster County. Ellenville Central School District in Ulster County, and Pine Bush Central School District and Minisink Valley Central School District in Orange County, serve as some of the primary school districts for students living in parts of the Town of Mamakating. Port Jervis Central School District in Orange County serves as one of the primary school districts for students living in either the Town of Mamakating or the Town of Forestburgh in Sullivan County.

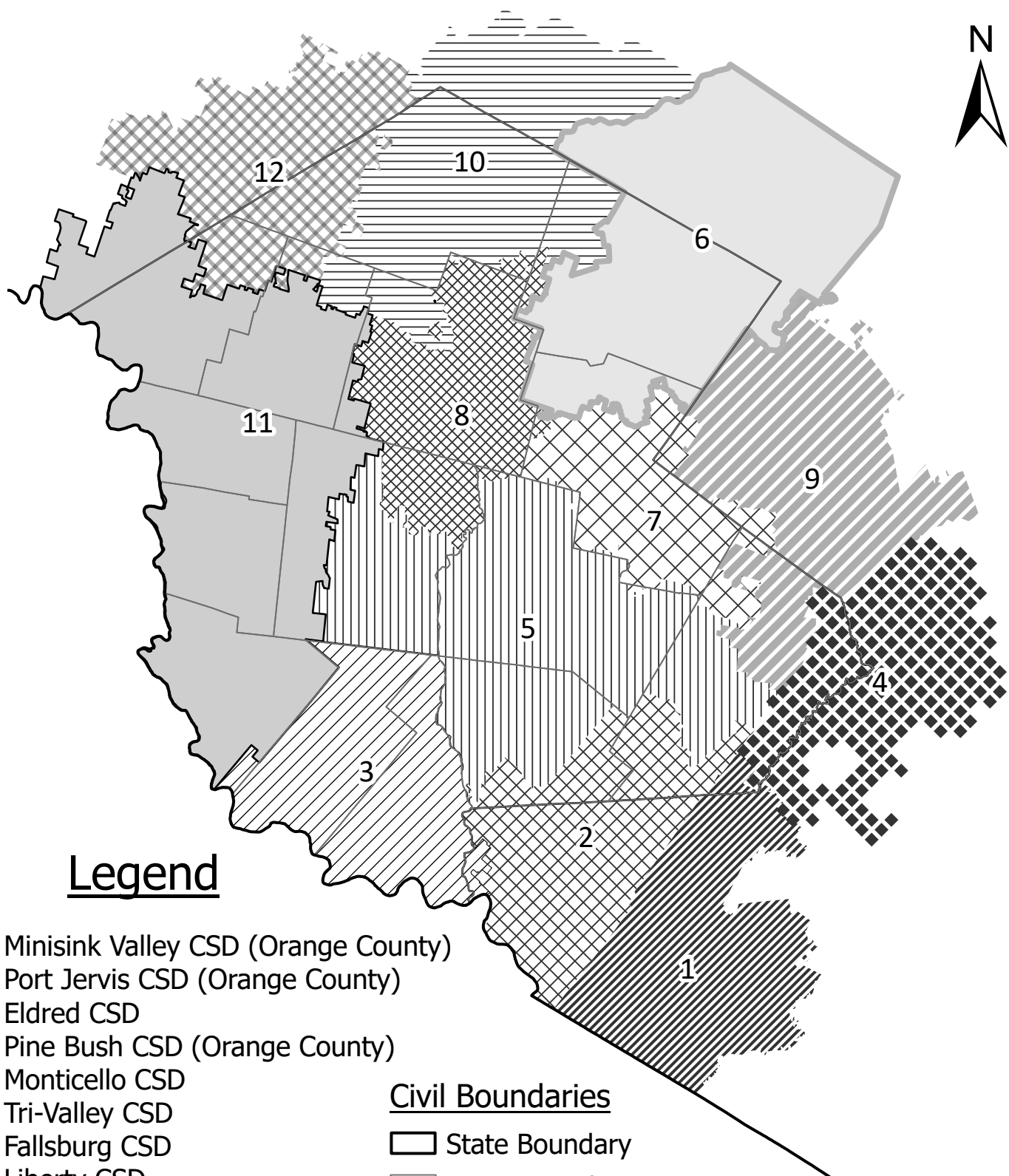
In 2021, the top 4 school districts in the County with the highest student enrollment were Monticello (2,778 students), Liberty (1,693 students), Fallsburg (1,437 students), and Sullivan West (997 students). Additionally, the top 4 school districts with the highest 4-year graduation rate in the County as of 2021 were Roscoe (94%), Eldred (91%), Sullivan West (86%), and Fallsburg and Monticello both having a graduation rate of 78%.

The drop out rates for Sullivan County have been declining since 2018 and 2019, when the County's overall dropout rate was estimated to be at 12%. Comparatively during the same time period, Sullivan County's drop out rate was 5-6% higher than both Orange and Ulster County. By 2021, Sullivan County's dropout rate had decreased from 12% to 8%, whereas Orange and Ulster County experienced little to no change in their dropout rates from 2018 to 2021, remaining around 5-6% for each respective County.

According to the 2020 American Community Survey, in 2020 Sullivan County had an estimated population of 53,315 individuals aged 25 years or older. In regards to the highest level of educational attainment amongst this estimated population, 17,230 individuals had completed high-school (including those with equivalency diplomas), 9,412 individuals had completed *some college, no degree*, and 7,808 individuals had earned their bachelor's degree. Additionally, as of 2020, 5,563 individuals in the County aged 25 years or older had earned their associate's degree, 4,244 individuals had completed their education anywhere between 9th to 12th grade with no diploma, and 2,708 individuals had not continued their education beyond 9th grade.

Public School Districts Sullivan County, New York

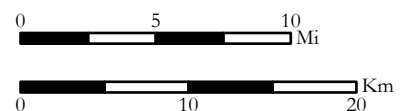

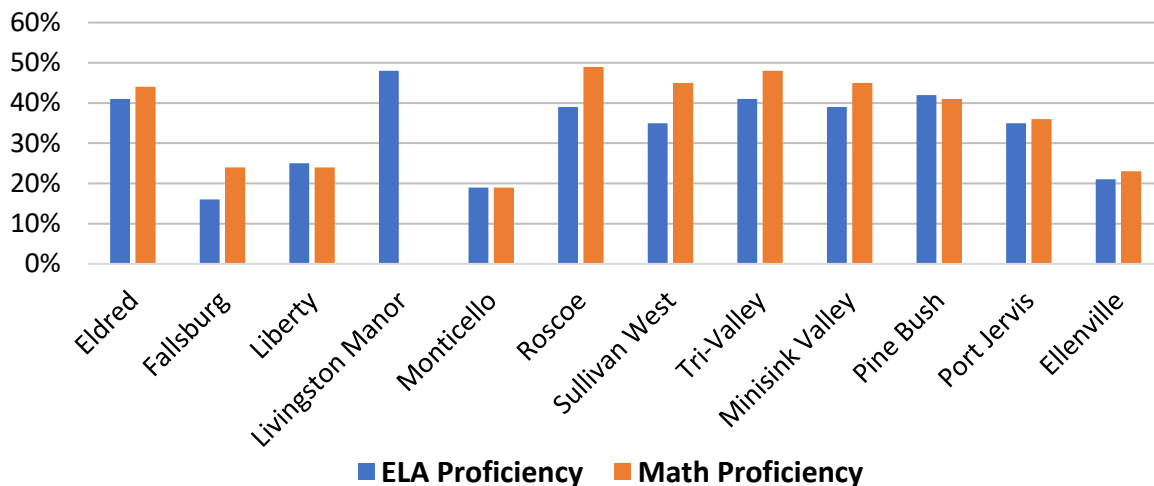

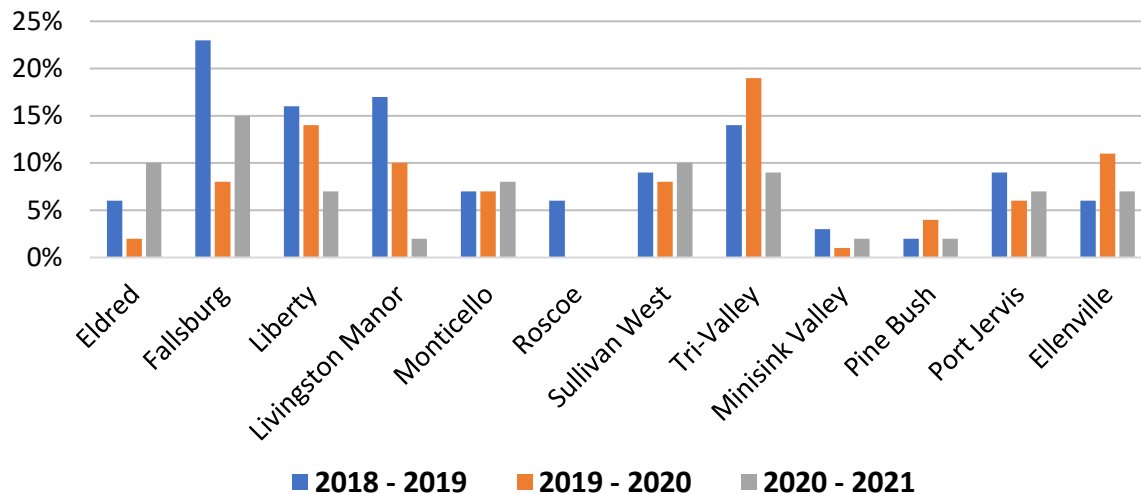

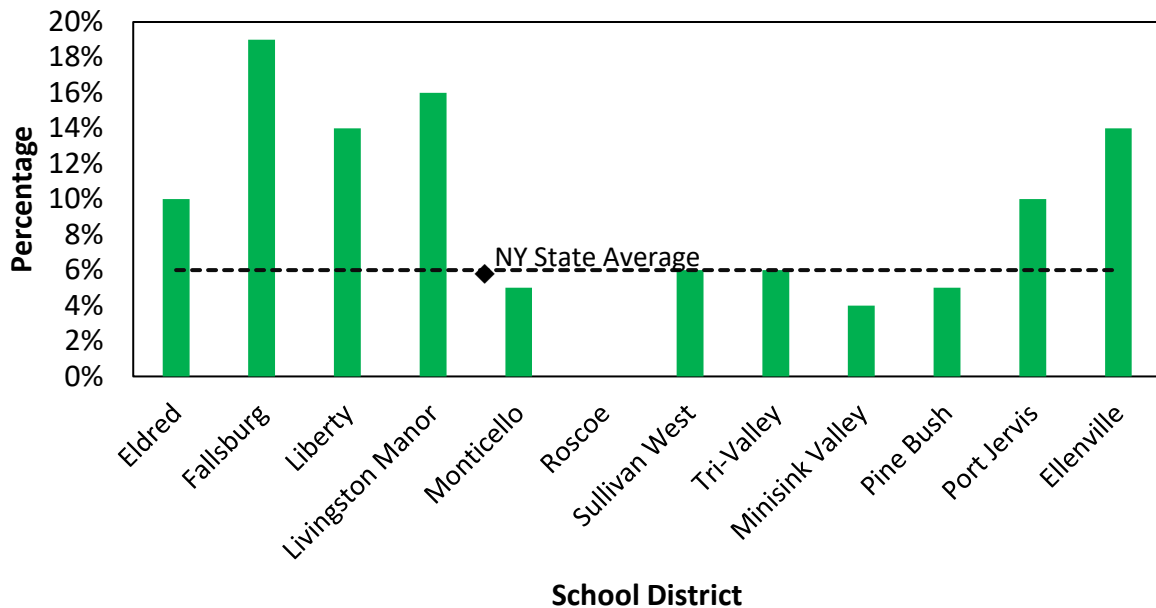
