Dr. Argenziano will also discuss contemporary treatments for coronary artery disease, valve disorders, aneurysms, and structural heart disease, including minimally invasive procedures, coronary stenting, transcatheter valve therapies such as TAVR, robotic and hybrid approaches, and modern heart surgery techniques. The session will offer insight into how these rapidly evolving technologies are improving outcomes, shortening recovery times, and expanding treatment options for patients with complex cardiovascular disease.
