Arson Task Force: No report

911: The technology we are using is outdated, major upgrades are needed. The next few years will see significant upgrades to the system. We have received approximately 1.5 million from NYS the next generation of 911.

Communications Committee: They will be meeting again tomorrow. Progress has been made to address the issues raised by the Battalion 5 letter. Miscommunications are being addressed.

EMS: The grant money from the State is not yet available.

The Fly car has proven to be very helpful and has cut down on response times.
