The social case work is performed under direct supervision of a supervisory level Caseworker. The Caseworker in consultation with the supervisor formulates and carries out plans to meet the individual needs of the cases assigned. Does related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

(A) Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with a Bachelor's Degree or higher. or

(B) Be certified as a Registered Nurse with one (1) year of experience in that position. Requirements:
