Overview: The Children's Home of Wyoming is seeking Community Based Providers in Liberty.

The Community Based Provider provides Psychosocial Rehabilitation Services (PSR) and Community Psychiatric Support and Treatment (CPST).

Develop and maintain therapeutic relationships with youth and their families that remains responsive to their needs, promotes the caregiver-child relationship, and is in accordance with the established treatment plan.

Timely identify and effectively communicate all behavioral, emotional or medical needs with consented providers that are involved in the youth's care.

Confer regularly with the program supervisor, licensed professional, and program director as needed on each child's progress.

Providers are responsible for completing required administrative functions, including scheduling visits with child/youth, planning activities with youth, and completing all documentation requirements in a timely manner.

Providers are responsible for providing safe transportation as a part of service delivery.

Providers must collaborate with child/youth, family members, and other involved service providers to provide comprehensive care.
