Test faulty equipment to diagnose malfunctions, using test equipment or software, and applying knowledge of the functional operation of electronic units and systems.

Inventorying all tools including implementation of a checkout procedure to account for tools, lubricants, and other items.

Maintain machine & equipment manuals and create basic troubleshooting guidelines for use in daily operation.

Following all policies on safety standards and protocol for all equipment.

Assist in the maintenance of the company's fleet of PITs (Power Industrial Trucks) including routine maintenance, emergency maintenance, and repair.
