Responsible for school-based services such as assessment, clinical intervention, consultation and education to school professionals, and advocacy and referral to needed services for children deemed as at-risk. The work schedule mirrors the Department of Education with school recess vacations.

Conduct training seminars with school personnel relative to at-risk students.

Be available to new students and their families during the adjustment and transition to new school and community.

Participate in child study meetings, attendance committee, retention/promotion meetings as needed.

Evaluate CSE students to determine counseling needs.

Maintain accurate, current case records.

Evaluate program effectiveness using appropriate research design.

Participate in staff development and training programs within the agency.

Attend meetings and conferences mutually agreed upon by Astor staff and school administration.
